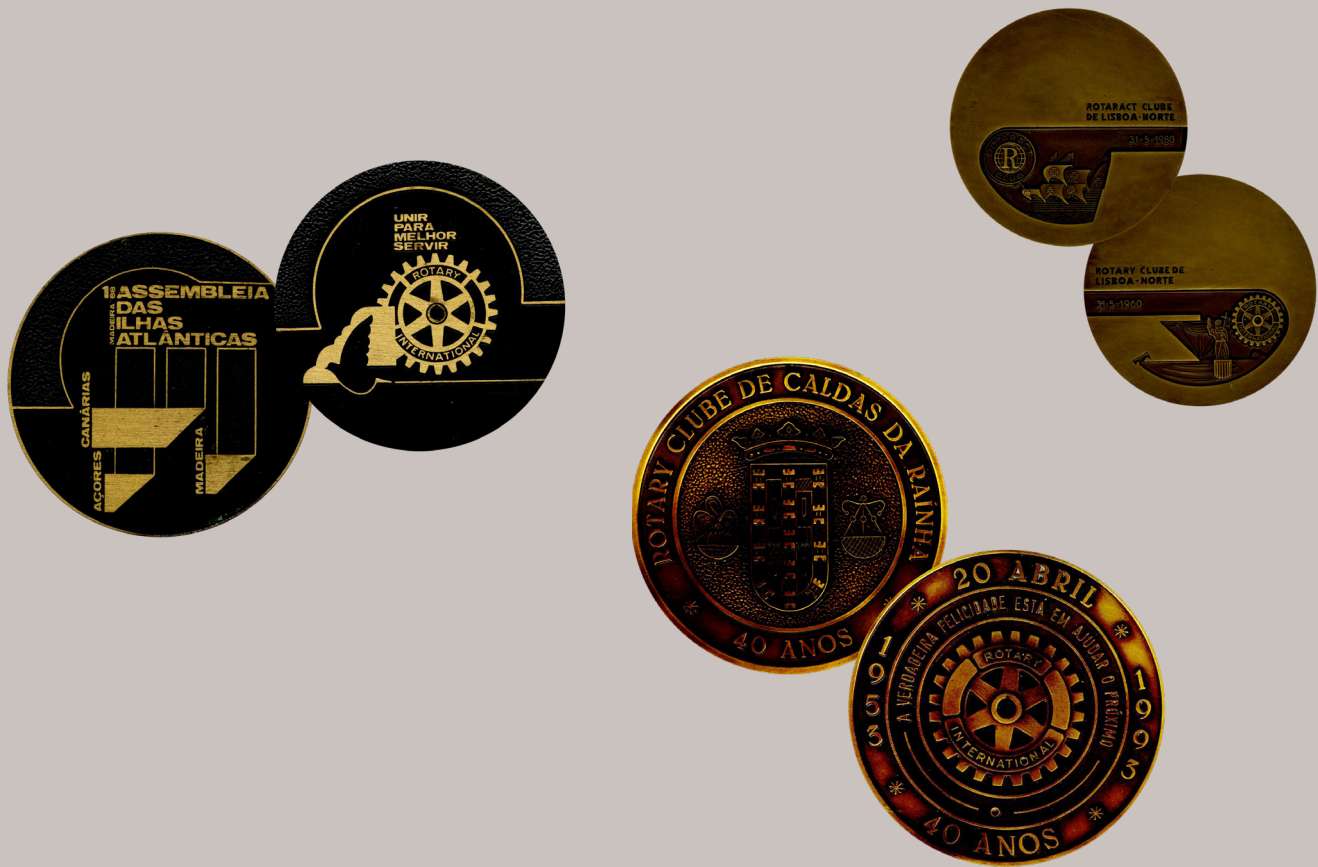

## AGREEMENT on Matched Clubs

It is hereby agreed between Rotary Club of Kawasaki Chuoh, District 259 of Rotary International and Rotary Club of Kona, District 500 of Rotary International that matched clubs shall be concluded as follows:

- Article 1. The object of mached clubs is to promote understanding and goodwill between U.S.A. and Japan for world peace.
- Article 2. We shall keep in communication with each other on club activities and informations for reference of each club's administration. If necessary, these informations shall be reported in club bulletins.
- Article 3. A club member shall manage to attend the weekly meeting of the matched club when he visits our country. He shall introduce the recent condition of his club and make efforts to bring out mutual understanding and goodwill.
- Article 4. In the case that a club member and his family of the matched club visit our country or that the mached club asks for our cooperation, we shall suit their convenience and look after within our capability.
- Article 5. We shall be interested in mutual activities of community service and be encouraged to work together.
- Article 6. The terms which have not yet provided shall be discussed whenever necessary.
