## "Chase Bank" Phishing Scam



ing Scam. One huge giveaway was that the "From:" was Chase Business, not Chase Bank, and the treeply email had nothing to do with Chase Bank or "noreply@chase.com." It seems that these days we have to be so extra vigilant of our data.

Good News, Scary News, and Climate News: #1 - Good News: Starting off with great news, employment is at a literal peacetime high. More good news, our current president has placed more women in top jobs than any president in history, and Black American unemployment is at its lowest level since records have been kept. The vast majority of all these "end of the world" type studies are the result of yet one more private or government funded grant study. In many cases it is people working on a PhD, or a company that was created for and specializes in "obtaining grants" and "doing studies."
